Organization, activities and priorities in the present stage

1. Every Community groups together messengers of whatever affiliation and members who are exclusively messengers (who form the nucleus or Commission). The Commission is formed with a minimum of three members. The Community meets according to the agreement of the Commission. Retreats and Seminars are also carried out according to the agreements of the members. The meetings of the Community of the Message are open to everyone but when a person wishes to include themselves in a particular community they do so by carrying out the Ceremony of Recognition before it.
2. Each Community creates its own web page. We also have an official web (elmensajedesilo.net) for the Spanish and Portuguese languages and an official web (silosmessage.net) for diverse languages.
3. In the global campaign to raise awareness (World March for Peace and Non Violence 2009) the communities will try to reach out to local cultural communities giving talks about the mobilization. They also carry out diverse public activities, clearly manifesting their support for the WM as well as the support demanded by the public.
4. During these activities, a support card can be filled out by the public and, where appropriate, can be used to invite people to meetings of the Message.

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
